chosen to honor the unique sports cars of Donald Healey. The Healey Car Company formed in 1945 introduced the Elliott Saloon in 1947 and then the Silverstone in 1949. Both cars enjoyed success in the Alpine Rallies. Other Healey models included the Westland Roadster, Sportsmobile, Tickford Saloon, Abbott Drophead Coupe, and the G-Type Roadsters. From 1951 to 1954 the two seater Nash-Healey was produced for the American market. The classic "Big Healey" was introduced by Austin-Healey in 1952. These are the most recognizable and desired cars. Donald Healey finished his career at Jensen Motors where he became Chairman in 1972. As always, all sports cars are encouraged to attend, the 2013 Show had 110 cars registered, we are hoping to set a new record this year.

Alden is a charming little village on the shores of Torch Lake the third most beautiful lake in the world according to National Geographic magazine. There are many unique and pleasant shops in town.
